# SEMINAR

**A COMPARATIVE CONVERSATION ON CONSTITUTIONS:  
IMPLICATIONS AND THE RECOGNITION OF 'UNWRITTEN  
RIGHTS' IN AUSTRALIA AND ISRAEL**

**Speakers:** the Hon. Justice Daphne Barak-Erez (Justice, Supreme Court of Israel) and the Hon. Kenneth Hayne AC QC (former Justice High Court of Australia)
